B. Objects Required:

A small basket, a couple of Red and Yellow bell peppers, one capsicum, a few loose mushrooms. A frying pan. A spatula.

Arrangement:

Place all items to make a suitable and visually appealing arrangement. Candidates should be able to see all items clearly.
