Except where the question asks for a particular medium to be used, candidates are recommended to consider their choice of media and processes and are reminded that the following are permissible: coloured inks, poster and water-colour, stencil, wax resist, collage or printing from lino, potato, vegetable or fruit or the use of any material such as hardboard or string which will give an interesting texture.

## Attempt any one of the following topics stating its number:

1. Design a repeat pattern for a decorative paper to be used for wrapping birthday presents. Use four colours only.
2. Design the cover of a travel magazine. Incorporate the title 'ON THE GO', in your design. The cover illustration should reflect the type of travel experience being offered. No other text is necessary.
3. A bake sale is being organized in your school. The proceeds from the sale will go for charity. Design a poster to advertise the forthcoming event. Create a suitable slogan for the poster and include a date and time of the sale into your design.
4. A theatre is hosting a play called 'The Grand Old Lion'. Design a brochure giving the time, date and venue. A suitable illustration should be incorporated. Use two colours only.
5. Design a logo for a farmer selling organic farm produce. Work within an 8 " diameter or $8 " \times 6$ " rectangle. Incorporate the words, 'GREEN GROW’ in your design.
